Parade Route—on First Street (Next to First Financial Bank) - East on Highway Ave. to Main Square

Rules and guidelines:

- *No political advertising
- *No throwing any items from parade units
- Children under 12 may not pass out items along parade route
- 🏕 No leaving garbage in the line- up area
- *No alcoholic beverages
- 🏞 Fire extinguishers are required for all floats
- *No stopping your entry during parade
- * All entries must have lights




