February 19 from 10:00am-1:00pm.

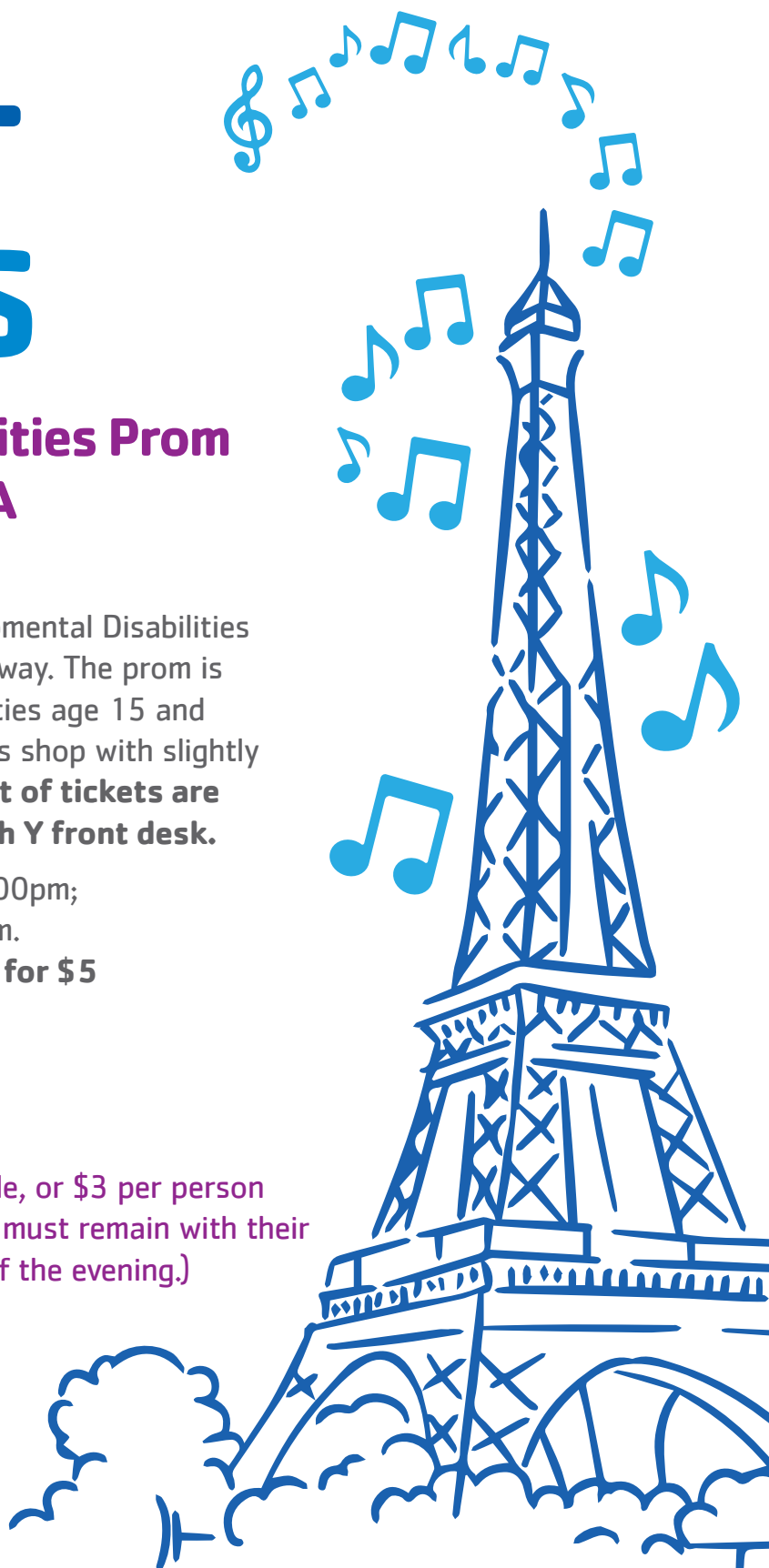

In February, 2013, Schererville resident Kailey Florkiewicz (now 13) was diagnosed with Niemann-Pick Disease Type C, a rare, degenerative disease that affects mostly children. NPC is commonly referred to as pediatric Alzheimer's because the symptoms and progression of the two are very similar, including: loss of muscle control, deterioration of speech, seizures and dementia, leading to neurological and intellectual decline. Currently there is no cure for this disease, and life expectancy is in the teens.

On Sunday, May 21, 2017 the community will come together for a Walk Fundraiser, which will also include food, shopping, silent auction, air rides and an aviation themed open house. 100% of all funds raised at the walk will go to the National Niemann-Pick Disease Foundation for research for a cure. We are seeking support from local businesses to help with our fundraising efforts. There are several ways local businesses can help. Thank you for your consideration.
