Vince's Journey

While Vince Bossi lives in St. John, Indiana, this year he will spend his 15th birthday at his current residence: Mayo Clinic in Minnesota.

Vince's journey began when he started having medical issues in August of 2015. By December of that year he had double vision and debilitating headaches. A year of weekly trips to U of I Hospital in Chicago followed. These visits included having regular spinal taps, blood tests, eye exams, infusions and five inpatient stays.

Now at Mayo's, he's undergone surgery and countless tests as the doctors there consult with specialists in NY, Denver and UCLA to name a few. Vince has diminished vision in one eye and inhibited mobility. While they search for answers, the doctors are working diligently on improving his strength and mobility. After hospitalization, Vince will remain in-patient at Mayo's for weeks of rehabilitation. He then will undergo weeks of out-patient, full day physical therapy at Mayo's.

Vince's sense of humor is one of a kind. He loves playing Xbox with his "Squad", Legos, Pokemon cards, family and friends, though not in that order! He wants to get better and be home. He wants to go to school and go to the movies to see shows like Star Wars: Rogue One and the Lego Batman movie with friends and family. Like Vince, we all want that for him.

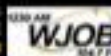

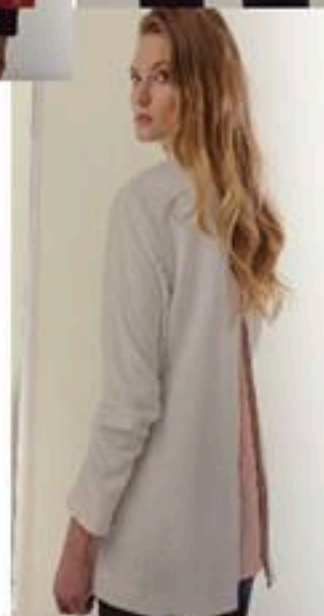
