

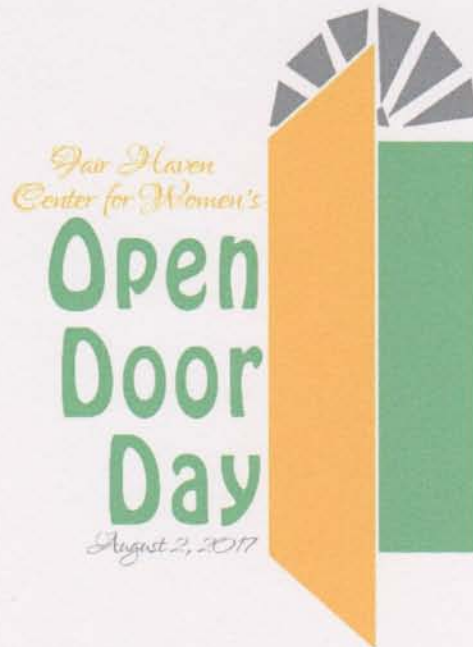

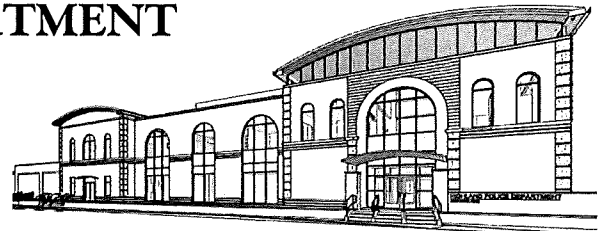

## Citizen's Police Academy

The Highland Police Department will be conducting its next Citizen's Police Academy in the Fall of 2017. Plans are currently being made to begin classes on September 12<sup>th</sup>. Applicants must be 18 years of age or older and be a Highland resident or the owner or employee of a Highland business.

The Citizens' Police Academy will consist of a ten-week program designed to give the public a working knowledge of the Highland Police Department. The classes will be held every Tuesday from 7:00 P.M. to 9:30 P.M. at the Community Room of the Highland Police Dept. at 3315 Ridge Rd. The instruction is comprehensive, and each week a different facet of Police Department operations will be covered. Police Department personnel, along with guest speakers from the Clerk-Treasurer's Office and the Lake County Courts will discuss topics such as training, budget, staffing, patrol techniques, communications, criminal law and much more. Instruction will consist of lectures, demonstrations, and tours. Also included will be a ride-along program with members of the Highland Police Department.

The slogan of the Citizens' Police Academy is "Understanding Through Education". The goal is to provide enough information to the public to dispel suspicions and misconceptions, and to improve the communication and working relationship between the citizens of Highland and the police officers.

We hope graduates of the Citizens' Police Academy will be more aware and better informed about how the Highland Police Department operates and will recommend to their friends, co-workers, and families that they join us in this rewarding program.
