

- Festival hours will be from 11 AM to 3 PM. All participants will be present for the entire duration of the festival. Set up will be from 10 AM to 11 AM and tear down will be from 3 PM to 4 PM.
- 2) Vendors with booths must bring their own booth/display and signage must be attached to the booth/display. Items for sale must be sold only from the booth. No food items shall be sold or given away by vendors.
- 3) Booth space is \$25 for a 10' x 10' space, except for government agencies, as determined by Highland Main Street (HMS). The footprint must fit inside that space. Electricity is not available at this site. Small generators (ex: 2000 watt/15 amps), arranged and paid for by the applicant, are permitted, provided the generator does not cause, in the discretion of HMS, a noise or smell nuisance and is located and used in a safe manner.
- 4) Applications and booth fees (CHECK MADE PAYABLE TO "TOWN OF HIGHLAND") should be submitted to Lance Ryskamp, Redevelopment Commission Assistant, Town of Highland, 3333 Ridge Road, Highland, IN 46322, lryskamp@highland.in.gov, 219-972-7598. Applications and booth fees are due, and postmarked, by September 15, 2017, and shall be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis, as space permits. Emailed applications are permitted, looth space, Accepted vendors will be notified by September 22nd. Decisions by HMS are final.
