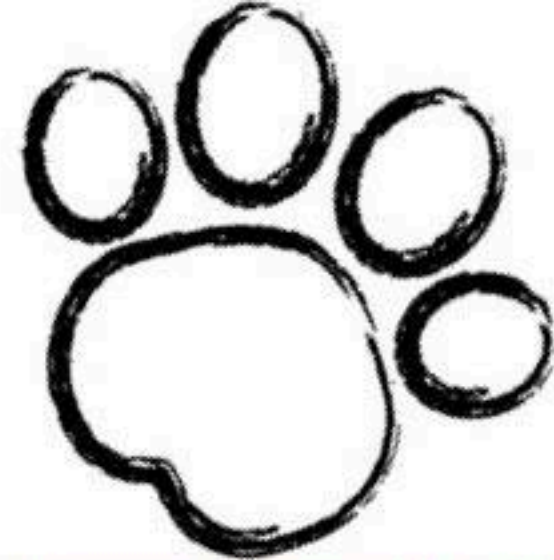

REGULATIONS FOR THE FESTIVAL:

- 1) Festival hours will be from 11 AM to 3 PM. All participants will be present for the entire duration of the festival. Set up will be from 10 AM to 11 AM and tear down will be from 3 PM to 4 PM.
- 2) Vendors with booths must bring their own booth/display and signage must be attached to the booth/display. Items for sale must be sold only from the booth. No food items shall be sold or given away by vendors.
- 3) Booth space is \$25 for a 10' x 10' space, except for government agencies, as determined by Highland Main Street (HMS). The footprint must fit inside that space. Electricity is not available at this site. Small generators (ex: 2000 watt/15 amps), arranged and paid for by the applicant, are permitted, provided the generator does not cause, in the discretion of HMS, a noise or smell nuisance and is located and used in a safe manner.
- 4) Applications and booth fees (CHECK MADE PAYABLE TO "TOWN OF HIGHLAND") should be submitted to Lance Ryskamp, Redevelopment Commission Assistant, Town of Highland, 3333 Ridge Road, Highland, IN 46322, lyskamp@highland.in.gov, 219-972-7598. Applications and booth fees are due, and postmarked, by September 15, 2017, and shall be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis, as space permits. Emailed applications are permitted, but both the application and the booth fee must be submitted to complete the application process. An emailed application DOES NOT reserve you a booth space. Accepted vendors will be notified by September 22nd. Decisions by HMS are final. Any applications submitted after the deadline may be accepted, at the discretion of HMS, subject to space availability and the following priority criteria: Artists/artisans; Highland nonprofits or retail

businesses; Northwest Indiana nonprofits and retail businesses; and, Service businesses, unrelated to the arts and health/fitness.

5) Direct Sales businesses are permitted, subject to the limitation of one representative per company, as determined by receipt of an application and booth fee, on a first-come, first-serve basis. The decision by HMS is final.

I will abide by the above regulations and if any display or product is deemed objectionable by HMS, it must be removed promptly upon notification.
