Dear Business Owner,

Ryan Myszak is a 37 year old father, husband and Christian community member of Munster. In 2012 Ryan and his high school sweetheart, Lacie, welcomed their youngest daughter Lexie into the world after 7 years of struggling with infertility and miscarriage. 5 months later they received a call from DCS with an offer to be foster parents to Lilly and Jill (now ages 8 and 5) and they became a family of 5 overnight. In February of 2014 after a very unpredictable year of fostering, the Myszak's petition to adopt Lilly and Jill was granted and their family was finally complete.

In November of last year the Myszak's faced tragedy as their youngest, Lexie, age 4 was diagnosed with T-Cell Leukemia and has been undergoing chemo since. She will continue treatment for the next 1 ½ years to keep her cancer in remission. In July 2017, Ryan himself was diagnosed with Multiple Myeloma and started chemo treatment which will continue until he has a Stem Cell Transplant scheduled for October 26, 2017. He will be unable to work much less perform his normal responsibilities as a father, husband and community member for approximately 2 to 3 months. During this time, they will have major financial strains.

- Festival hours will be from 11 AM to 3 PM. All participants will be present for the entire duration of the festival. Set up will be from 10 AM to 11 AM and tear down will be from 3 PM to 4 PM.
- 2) Vendors with booths must bring their own booth/display and signage must be attached to the booth/display. Items for sale must be sold only from the booth. No food items shall be sold or given away by vendors.
- 3) Booth space is \$25 for a 10' x 10' space, except for government agencies, as determined by Highland Main Street (HMS). The footprint must fit inside that space. Electricity is not available at this site. Small generators (ex: 2000 watt/15 amps), arranged and paid for by the applicant, are permitted, provided the generator does not cause, in the discretion of HMS, a noise or smell nuisance and is located and used in a safe manner.
