

Over the last few weeks, the Highland Police Department has taken several reports where people were "scammed" out of money by others calling them claiming to either be a family member who was arrested and in need of bond money or by people claiming to be a utility company collecting overdue utility bills. In most of these scams, the caller tells the victim that money is needed and that they can respond to a drug store such as a CVS or Walgreens or other stores such as a Best Buy, Walmart and Target store to purchase gift cards at those stores. The "scammer" then calls the victim back and then asks the victim for the gift card numbers and security code off the back of the gift card. At that point, the value is taken off of the gift card and the victim then suffers the financial loss without ever having relinquished the gift card. For several of the victims making recent police reports, the loss suffered was well into the thousands for each victim.


We are asking that store managers have a talk with their employees to be observant when people come into their stores and make large purchases of gift cards. If an employee would just take a moment to have a little conversation with the customer about large purchases of gift cards, those employees may save a customer from suffering a large financial loss. Unfortunately, most of the victims have been some of our elderly residents. By looking out for those who may be more vulnerable and just having a conversation with them, you may stop them from becoming a victim.

The Highland Police Department is starting a new program where Highland residents and businesses can voluntarily register their video surveillance systems with our police department. After the information is registered and confirmed with our department, it will be put into our database. Therefore, if a crime is committed in a particular area, officers will be able to check our map of registered cameras and we can see if there are any nearby cameras that might be of help to our officers and investigators. We will then made contact with that registered resident or business and ask that they check their own surveillance system to see if their cameras might have captured anything that may be of assistance to us.

This is a program that other police departments in the United States have been doing and we feel it is a great tool to have in order to assist our officers and investigators in following up on reported crimes. We want everyone to know that this program is free, voluntary and confidential. Only the Highland Police Department will have access to this database of registered video surveillance systems. We want to reemphasize – we are NOT gaining access to your surveillance system, but we are informing you to check your system should a crime have occurred in your vicinity.




