
Highland's Santa March & Light Parade

Rules and guidelines:

- No political advertising
- No throwing any items from parade units
- Children under 14 may not pass out items along parade route
- No leaving garbage in the line- up area
- No alcoholic beverages
- Fire extinguishers are required for all floats
- No stopping your entry during parade
- All entries must have lights -We have our parade in conjunction with the lighting of the downtown lights, we ask that everyone have lights of some type in their entry. In lieu of candy we are asking our participants to pass out items that glow/light up/ flash, however this is not required.
