Line- up- For all entries with vehicles: From Highway Ave., turn north onto 2nd street in downtown Highland. Follow the ally to Condit then to 1st, Street. Drop offs and walkers can park at the bank on the corner of Highway and 1st St.

Parade Route- First Street (Next to First Financial Bank) - East on Highway Ave. to Main Square

Rules and guidelines:

- No political advertising
- No throwing any items from parade units
- Children under 14 may not pass out items along parade route
- No leaving garbage in the line- up area
- No alcoholic beverages
- Fire extinguishers are required for all floats
- No stopping your entry during parade
- ❖ All entries must have lights -We have our parade in conjunction with the lighting of the downtown lights, we ask that everyone have lights of some type in their entry. In lieu of candy we are asking our participants to pass out items that glow/light up/ flash, however this is not required.
- ❖ Walkers are asked (but not required) to wear items that light up.
