Nicholas E. "Bud" and Hilda Leep began their dairy business on a farm near Lowell, Indiana in 1928, producing milk for the wholesale market. They started the retail business in 1932 in Highland, and the first dairy plant was built in 1934 on U.S. 41. Later the business expanded with the construction of a new larger plant in 1948 at 2625 Highway Ave. which is still in operation today. Pleasant View's retail business is now in its 87th year and celebrating 91 years since its founding. Come listen to Ken Leep, son of the founders, tell about his parent's humble beginnings and the many business hardships the family encountered along the way. Ken will take us from farm to milk store, to dairy plant, home delivery business on through to the present day success of one of The Calumet Region's oldest and well known business, which is still family owned and operated.

Ken has lived the dairy business all his life and has a great story to share. Please join us for an interesting and entertaining evening of true American entrepreneurship.


