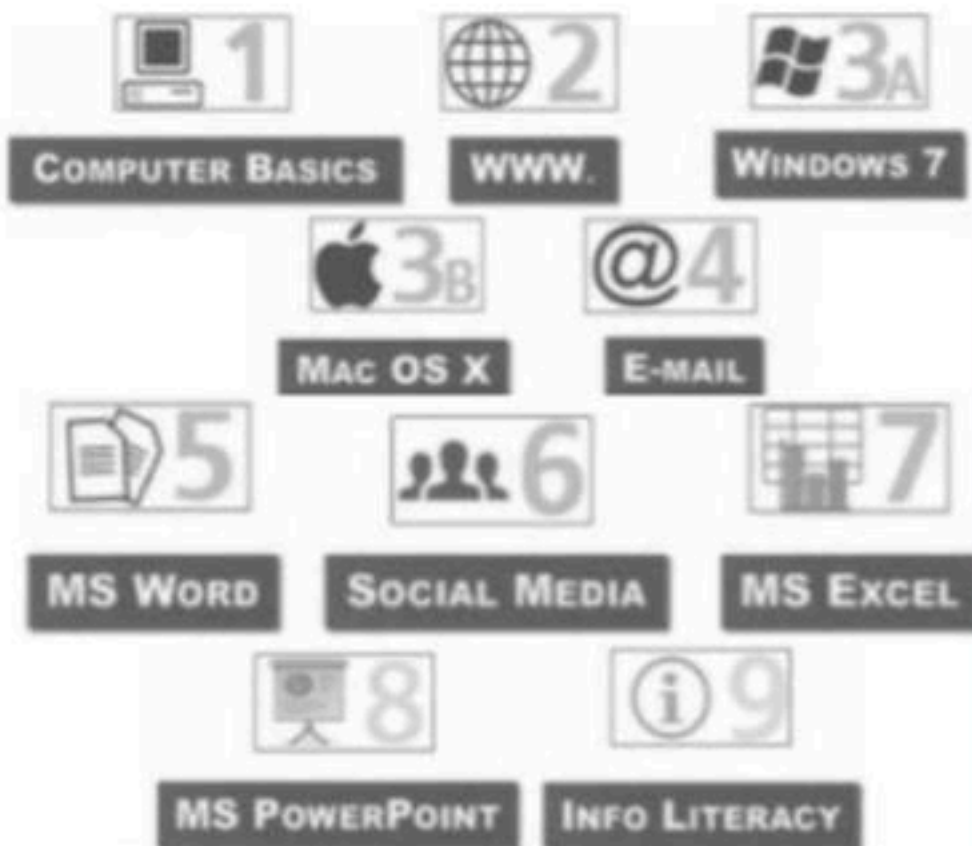

# NORTHSTAR DIGITAL LITERACY PROGRAM



## WHAT IS NORTHSTAR DIGITAL LITERACY?

The Northstar Digital Literacy Project defines basic skills needed to perform tasks on computers and online. The ability of adults to perform these tasks can be assessed through online, self-guided modules.

Included are basic computer digital literacy standards and modules in ten main areas: Basic Computer Use, Internet, Windows Operating System, Mac OS, Email, Microsoft Word, Social Media, Microsoft Excel, Microsoft PowerPoint, and Information Literacy.

Northstar is an assessment, not a curriculum. When individuals pass the assessments at approved sites, they can obtain the Northstar Digital Literacy Certificate. This provides a credential for employment. There is no cost to complete the online assessments.

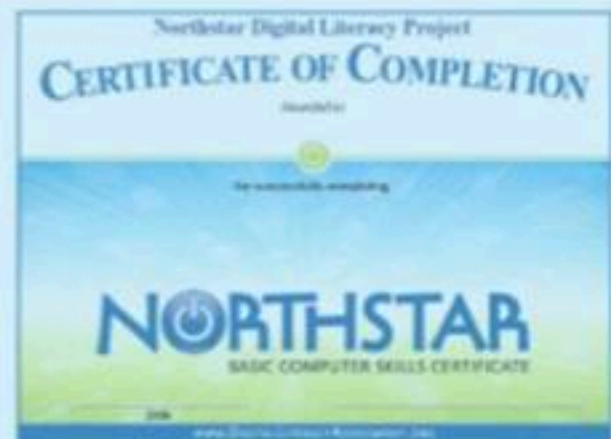

**Parade Rules:**

**ABSOLUTELY NO THROWING OF ANY ITEMS FROM PARADE VEHICLES!** You must walk along the sides of the parade route and hand items out. See attached Police Notice.

- No alcoholic beverages in line up or on parade route at ANY TIME.
- Not allowed- political advertising "vote", "elect", "nominate", "retain" "for" etc.
- No leaving garbage in the line- up areas. Please clean up your area.
- Fire extinguishers are required for all floats
- No selling along parade route
- Entry Name must be identified with a sign or banner!
- No vehicle entry for line up before 4:30pm or after 5:30pm
- ALL vehicles in your entry MUST be present BEFORE you check in. No exceptions!
- No additional vehicles (of any kind) will be allowed in once your entry is in place
- No vehicles of any kind may enter or exit the line up once checked in
- Only vehicles participating in the parade are allowed in the checkpoint lineup areas.
- Any rude, negative, or disruptive behavior may result in IMMEDIATE entry removal and suspension from future Highland Council of Community Events. This includes interaction with parade staff and volunteers and social media posts.
- A NOISE SENSITIVE AREA will extend from Kennedy Ave and 45th up to Highway Avenue. No sirens, loud horns, or loud noises of any kind in this area. The restriction is lifted between Highway Ave to the Fire Station, and then is in effect the remainder of the parade route.
- You must stop at designated check point and check in with the parade staff. They will guide you to your line up spot. **DO NOT CROSS BARRICADES!!!!\***

I have read and agree to follow the listed Highland Council of Community Events Parade Rules and Guidelines. I Understand, it is my responsibility to inform all participants in my entry of the rules. I am responsible for the actions of entry participants. Any rule or guideline violation may result in the entry being pulled from the parade and will be considered for possible suspension /rejection of any entry in any future Highland parade.

- Indemnity Agreement - In consideration of the acceptance of this application, applicant (person or organization) agrees to save and hold harmless all officers, members and agents of the Highland Council of Community Events, the Civil Town of Highland Indiana, as well as its agents and other persons or organizations which are assisting in conducting the Highland parade for the Town of Highland Indiana from any loss or damage whatsoever to person or property arising out of participation in our parade related activities, and further agrees to defend said personnel from any claim for damage related thereto.\*
